SECURING SHARED OFFICE SPACES USING THE CLOUD


Eagle Eye CameraManager helped SKEPP look out for the safety of its tenants and their property

How do you secure a place where the doors are always open? “Our buildings are shared by more than one company. There are multiple conference rooms and flexible working spaces. This provides an open, modern, and creative atmosphere, but it also makes it difficult to track who’s coming and going - especially since there are multiple locations scattered throughout the Benelux. Bringing our security to the cloud helped us monitor all locations from one central place,” Brookhuis explains.

CONFIGURE THE RIGHT SETTINGS

“Of course we are not constantly monitoring all footage. Luckily with CLVR we don’t have to.” Eagle Eye CameraManager’s smart analytics tool, CLVR, analyses all recorded footage and ‘sees’ an object or human. Next to that, it has the ability to set virtual borderlines (tripwires) or ‘hot’ areas to watch extra carefully. This way a big part

of the monitoring can be automatized making it manageable to track multiple cameras on multiple locations.” Brookhuis said.

“We learned the hard way that we needed some motivation to get a surveillance solution installed in our buildings,” Sven Brookhuis said. “Getting a system had been on our to-do list for some time, but after a break-in we gave it the priority it should have gotten earlier.”
