Eagle Eye Cloud VMS Subscriptions Explained

Target Audience

This Application Note is to help Eagle Eye Networks' Resellers understand the different Eagle Eye Cloud Video Management System (VMS) camera subscriptions, how to identify them on the price list, and to provide an explanation of what each camera subscription provides.

Introduction

The Eagle Eye Cloud VMS is delivered via Eagle Eye subscription plans. An Eagle Eye Bridge or an Eagle Eye CMVR is required for most installations but Camera Direct offerings also exist, which eliminates the need for a Bridge/CMVR for smaller installations. All subscriptions are priced per camera and can be purchased as a monthly, yearly, or 3-year/5-year basis, however, charges are deducted monthly from the credit amount on the account for yearly and multi-year subscriptions. This is outlined monthly on your billing invoice/statement. The price and part number vary based upon camera resolution and the desired retention period. There are no additional charges for the use of the Cloud VMS or Eagle Eye Viewer App as they are included as part of your camera subscription.

Categorizations of Camera Resolutions

The camera resolutions are categorized as follows:

- **M10:** Local recording or live viewing up to the supported camera resolution. No cloud storage.*
- **PR1:** Camera with preview stream cloud recording only. The video stream will be recorded on-premise only. (340 x 280) or (640 x 360)
- **SD1:** IP or Analog cameras NTSC or PAL up 0.6MP (640 X480).
- **HD1:** Up to 1MP (1280 x 720) IP cameras.
- **HD2:** Up to 2MP (1920 x 1080) IP cameras.
- **HD3:** Up to 3MP (2048 x 1536) IP cameras.
- **HD4:** Up to 4MP (2688 x 1520) IP cameras.

- **HD5:** Up to 5MP (2592 x 1944) IP cameras.
- **HD10:** Over 5MP up to 10MP.
 - 6MP (3072 x 2048) IP cameras.
 - 8MP/4K (3840 x 2160) IP cameras.
 - 10MP (3648 x 2752) IP cameras.
- **HD15:** Over 10MP.

Cloud Retention Period Options

Eagle Eye offers many options for Cloud retention periods. The retention periods are as follows:

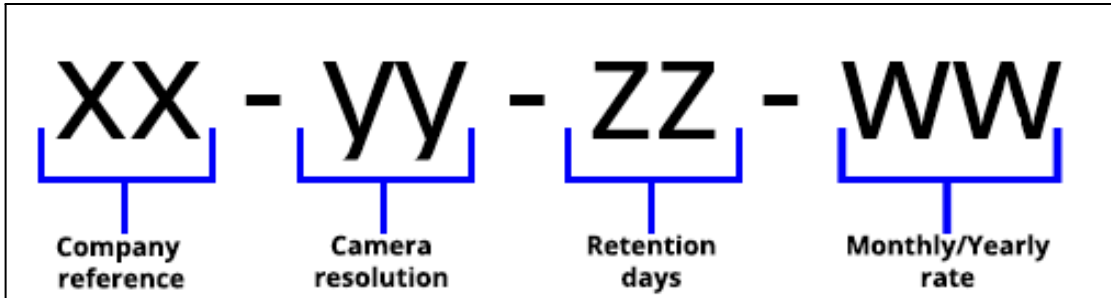
*Eagle Eye Networks also offers an **M10** subscription which refers to a 'no cloud retention option', which is often used in conjunction with the Eagle Eye **Cloud Managed Video Recorders (CMVRs)**. The CMVR can record and store video locally to the maximum of its storage space. You can record locally on the CMVR and also record to the cloud. Note however, that if choosing to record locally as well as in the cloud that only one resolution option is possible. For example, you cannot record locally at 5MP and then record to the cloud at 1MP. They have to match.

The M10 subscription also includes an optional one day cloud retention for the preview stream. The PR1 subscriptions store the preview stream in the cloud for a specified period of time for faster user interface response.

How to Identify a Camera Subscription on the Price List

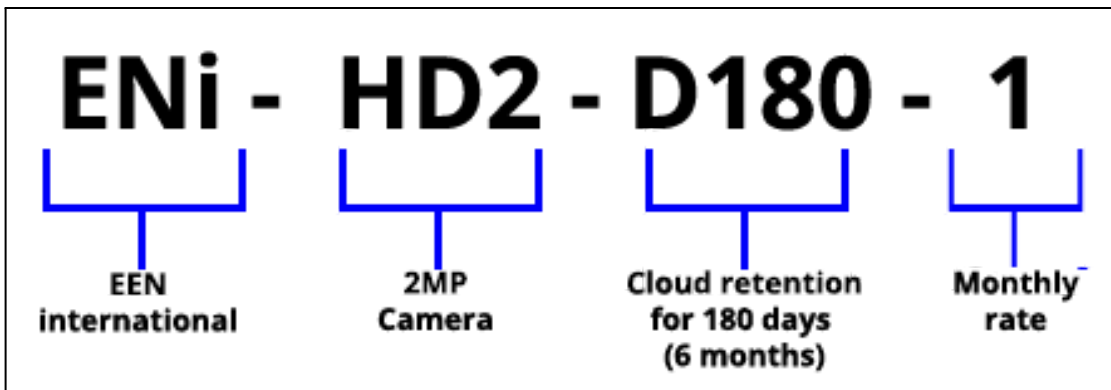
To identify camera subscriptions on the price list, refer to the section titled, Eagle Eye VMS Camera Subscriptions (per camera channel). Look for details specifying camera resolution options, retention days, and whether the pricing is listed on a monthly, yearly or 3/5 year basis.

The Camera Subscription Part Numbers are formatted as below:



- **Company reference:**
 - **EN:** refers to Eagle Eye Networks (North America)
 - **ENi:** refers to Eagle Eye Networks international (outside North America)
- **Camera resolution:** refers to the resolution categories mentioned above.
- **Retention days:** refers to the retention period categories mentioned above.
- **Monthly/Yearly rate:**
 - **1 (month):** Monthly subscription
 - **12 (months):** Yearly subscription
 - **36 (months):** 3-year subscription
 - **60 (months):** 5-year subscription

By knowing how the SKU is structure, you will be able to interpret it as shown in the example below:



Camera Subscription References

To make things easier, a fast way to refer to an Eagle Eye VMS Camera subscription is by combining the camera resolution with its selected retention period. Check the following examples:

- **HD1-D7:** A 1MP camera with seven days of cloud retention.
- **HD10-D14:** A camera between 6 and 10MP (including 4k) with 14 days of cloud retention.
- **HD2-D30:** A 2MP camera with 30 days (1 month) of cloud retention.
- **SD1-D90:** An analog or VGA camera with 90 days (3 months) of cloud retention.
- **HD1-D365:** A 1MP camera with 365 days (1 year) of cloud retention.

- **M10:** A local retention and cloud management subscription (available for CMVRs and Bridges for live viewing only).
- **PR1-D30:** Cloud Recording camera's preview stream with 30 days retention.

The options below include the subscription period length as the suffix:

- **HD1-D30-12:** A 1MP camera with 30 days of retention billed every 12 months (1 year).
- **HD4-D14-36:** A 4MP camera with 14 days of retention billed every 36 months (3 years).
- **HD10-D7-60:** A 10MP camera with 7 days of retention billed every 60 months (5 years).
